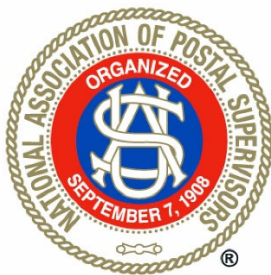

Continued: **Why Financial Wellness Matters in the Workplace**

Financial stress is one of the most common sources of ongoing stress for working adults. Rising costs, caregiving responsibilities, health-related expenses and uncertainty about benefits or retirement planning all can contribute to persistent pressure.
